The cyber job platform provider added that this decline is alarming and could impact national security, as some of these roles are essential for maintaining organizational and national cyber defenses.

The most significant decline is in research roles, which saw a general 69% drop year-on-year between 2022 and 2023.

According to CyberSN, this suggests a move away from proactive threat analysis and mitigation. Job postings for engineer roles have also significantly decreased, with the most posted role in the cybersecurity field, security engineer, experiencing a 21% drop.

"[This] represents a direct threat to our national cybersecurity infrastructure.

These roles are vital for developing secure products and integrating security throughout the development process, and their reduction is alarming," Deidre Diamond, founder and CEO of CyberSN.

Small ("Exempt") Companies Must meet one of three criteria

- Under 20 employees (including affiliates and contractors) OR
- Under 7.5 million in gross annual revenue OR
- Year end assets (including Affiliates) total less than 15 million

Non- Class A, Non- Exempt ("Standard") Companies

• Majority of DFS regulated entities

Large "Class A" Companies

- 2,000 employees
- 1 billion in gross annual revenue

Important Deadlines you Need to Know About:

April 15, 2024 Submit either a Certification of Compliance **or** an Acknowledgment of Non-Compliance for the 2023 calendar year.

April 29, 2024 Risk Assessments continued to be required and now must be reviewed and updated annually.

April 29, 2024 Annual Penetration testing required along with independent design and conduct of current cybersecurity audits.

Nov 1, 2024 Annual Cybersecurity training for personnel required to now include social engineering.
